Re: City of Oroville v. Superior Court (California Joint Powers Risk Management Authority) (Case No. S243247): Notice of New Authority

Honorable Chief Justice and Associate Justices:

I represent Petitioner City of Oroville ("City") in the above-captioned matter. I write under California Rules of Court, rule 8.520(d), to inform the Court of a new authority not available to be included in the City's merits briefs: Weiss v. People ex rel. Department of Transportation (Mar. 1, 2018, G052735) __ Cal.App.5th __ [2018 WL 1100944] ("Weiss").

Weiss concludes the motion authorized by Code of Civil Procedure section 1260.040 ("CCP 1260.040") to obtain a judicial determination of legal issues is limited to eminent domain actions and is unavailable in inverse condemnation actions like the case at bar. (Weiss, supra, at p. *2.) In doing so, the Court expressly disagrees with Dina v. People ex rel. Dept. of Transp. (2007) 151 Cal.App.4th 1029, which authorized a CCP 1260.040 motion in an inverse condemnation case. (Ibid.) It is relevant here because the appellate writ proceeding now pending before this Court arose from a ruling on a CCP 1260.040 motion.

That motion was brought by the WGS plaintiffs and no party preserved an objection for appeal to the trial court's resolving the merits of this case on such a motion.

If the Court would prefer the parties to provide supplemental briefing to discuss this new authority, the City would be happy to do so.
