To the Honorable Chief Justice and Associate Justices:

This letter is written to apprise the court and counsel of two cases, not cited before, which counsel expects to refer to in oral argument.

In In re Resendiz (2001) 25 Cal.4th 230, 246, fn. 9, this court held that, under Boykin v. Alabama (1969) 395 U.S. 238, (22 L.Ed. 244) and In re Tahl (1969) 1 Cal.3d 122, 131-132, due process requires the voluntary and intelligent waiver of all three constitutional rights at issue for a guilty plea to be valid.

In Danberry v. Pfister (7th Cir., 2015) 801 F.2d 863, 868-869, cert. denied, 2/29/16, 194 L.Ed.2d 182, 136 S. Ct. 1198, the court held that, under Boykin, supra, "[T]he correct standard on direct appeal of a constitutional claim [from a state court conviction] is the Chapman standard: whether the error was "harmless beyond a reasonable doubt." Johnson v. Acevedo 572 F.3d 398, 403 (2009) (citing Chapman v. California, 386 U.S. 18, 23, 17 L.Ed.2d 705, 87 S. Ct. 824 (1967))."
