DEFENDANT AND RESPONDENT SOUTHWIRE COMPANY'S JOINDER IN THE REPLY BRIEF ON THE MERITS OF DEFENDANT AND RESPONDENT ALCOA, INC.

Defendant and Respondent SOUTHWIRE COMPANY (hereinafter, "Southwire") hereby joins in the Reply Brief on the Merits filed by Defendant and Respondent ALCOA, INC (hereinafter, "Alcoa"). This joinder is filed pursuant to California Rules of Court, rule 8.200(a)(5), to avoid duplication and needless waste of paper, and yet to protect the interests of Southwire.

By this joinder, respondent Southwire hereby joins in and incorporates by reference the entire Reply Brief on the Merits filed by Alcoa.

Southwire is similarly situated to Alcoa in that Plaintiffs FLAVIO RAMOS, et al., make identical allegations as to each, and Southwire, like Alcoa, supplied raw materials for a manufacturing

process undertaken by Plaintiff Flavio Ramos' employer, who exercised total control over the process that allegedly gave rise to Plaintiff's claimed injuries. {9AA 2275:1 through 2276:19 and 2281:4 through 2291:21} (See also, Typed opn. 3-4.) The legal basis and reasoning set forth in Alcoa's Reply Brief on the Merits is equally available to Southwire.

Specifically, the allegations of the operative complaint directed to the aluminum supplying defendants – including Alcoa, Inc., Southwire and Century Kentucky - allege each provided aluminum ingots to Plaintiff's employer, which were then melted to a molten state and repurposed by Plaintiff's employer into products of its specification. (Typed opn. 4, 17) Southwire had no control over the design of Plaintiff's employer's product, nor the process by which that product was made, including the melting of the aluminum ingots supplied by Southwire, which process changed the nature of the ingots.

Workers injured on the job during the manipulation of non-defective raw materials for creation of or incorporation into new finished products should not be allowed to sue the suppliers of the non-defective raw materials for all of the reasons set forth in Alcoa's Reply Brief on the Merits. Further, a supplier of raw materials, like Southwire, owes no duty to warn an employee of a purchaser of those raw materials where the purchaser of the materials is a sophisticated manufacturer whose own manufacturing process changes the nature of the raw material and creates a hazard. The employee is protected by his own employer's specific and superior knowledge of the dangers the manufacturing process creates, the

employer's duty to provide a safe place to work, and the protections of the workers compensation system for injuries arising from his employer's plan, process and procedures in manipulation of the non-defective raw materials.

The Court should reverse the Court of Appeal and uphold the trial court's sustaining of the demurrer and dismissal of Plaintiffs' claims with prejudice.
