Dear Mr. McGuire:

The aforementioned case is set for oral argument on the afternoon of November 3, 2015.

We wish to bring to the Court's attention the following cases, which post-date the filing of the briefs in this matter.

People v. Mena (2012) 54 Cal.4th 146, 153-158 [denial of pretrial lineup is reviewable on direct appeal despite defendant's earlier failure to seek review by interlocutory writ] – This opinion negates a procedural bar we asserted in Argument I of respondent's brief.

United States v. Quinn (3d Cir. 2013) 728 F.3d 243,257[no authority of trial court to grant immunity to defense witness, abrogating Government of the Virgin Islands v. Smith (3d Cir. 1980) 615 F.2d 964] – This opinion is relevant to the issue raised in Argument VI, and supports the People's position.

Nevada v. Jackson (2013) __ U.S. __, 133 S.Ct. 1990, 1992 [state evidentiary rulings rarely violate defendant's right to present a defense]; Holmes v. South Carolina (2006) 547 U.S. 319, 326 [criticizing South Carolina evidentiary rule that served no legitimate purpose, but reaffirming the constitutionality of evidentiary rules that allow exclusion of evidence if its probative value is outweighed by other considerations]; People v. Robinson (2005) 37 Cal.4th 592, 627 fn.17 [noting grant of certiorari in Holmes and stating that South Carolina rule does not apply in California] — These opinions are relevant to Arguments IV and VII, and supports the People's position.

Glossip v. Gross (2015) ___ U.S. ___, 2732-2733135 S.Ct. 2726 [lethal injection does not violate Eighth Amendment]; Baze v. Rees (2008) 553 U.S. 35, 61-62 [same] – These opinions are relevant to the issue raised in Argument XVIII, and support the People's position.
