#### MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

Pursuant to Evidence Code sections 452 and 459, and California Rules of Court, rules 8.252(a) and 8.520(g), petitioner Board of Parole Hearings requests this Court take judicial notice of Exhibits Aa through Dd. These exhibits contain the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation's Division of Adult Parole Operation records, and the San Diego County Superior Court's minute orders, concerning William Palmer's progress on parole since his release from prison on March 11, 2019:

Exhibit Aa: June 4, 2019 Parole Revocation Decision Making Instrument.

**Exhibit Bb**: July 8, 2019 Parole Revocation Decision Making Instrument.

**Exhibit Cc**: September 17, 2019 Petition for Revocation.

**Exhibit Dd**: San Francisco County Superior Court Minute Orders, dated September 25, 2019, October 9, 2019, and October 25, 2019.

These exhibits are relevant to this matter for the reasons explained in the Board's opening brief on the merits. (Pet'r's Opening Brief (OB) at p. 35.) Briefly, the Court of Appeal held that because Palmer's continued incarceration was constitutionally excessive, he was entitled to discharge from parole. (Opn. at pp. 27-29.) On its own motion, this Court granted review and asked petitioner to address the proper remedy for a constitutionally disproportionate sentence. The Board's response to this question involves its broad authority to determinate how long and under what circumstances a life-term inmate should remain on parole, and the legislative and executive branch's determination that parole is important to an inmate's reintegration into society. (OB at p. 35.) Palmer's poor performance on parole is relevant to this latter point. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 8.252(a)(2)(A).)

The exhibits also are subject to judicial notice. (Cal. Rules of Court.) rule 8.252(a)(2)(C).) Under Evidence Code section 459, this Court may take judicial notice of any matter that would be subject to discretionary judicial notice by the trial court. (Evid. Code, § 459, subd. (a); see also People v. Jacinto (2010) 49 Cal.4th 263, 272, fn. 5 [appellate court may take judicial notice of matters that were not before the trial court]; Planned Parenthood Shasta-Diablo, Inc. v. Williams (1995) 10 Cal.4th 1009, 1021 [judicially noticing official government documents].) Under Evidence Code section 452, subdivision (c), courts may take judicial notice of "[o]fficial acts of the legislative, executive, and judicial departments of the United States and of any state of the United States." This includes CDCR's records as maintained by the Division of Adult Parole Operations concerning Palmer's parole. (See, e.g., In re Arroyo (2019) 37 Cal.App.5th 727, 730 [judicially noticing CDCR's relevant records and regulations]: CDCR's Division of Adult Parole Operations < https://www.cdcr.ca.gov/parole/> [as of Oct. 28, 2019].) Courts may also take judicial notice of "[r]ecords of . . . any court of this state[,]" such as the superior court's minute orders. (Evid. Code, § 459, subd. (d); Arce v. Kaiser Foundation Health Plan, Inc. (2010) 181 Cal. App. 4th 471, 483 [judicially noticing state-court pleadings].)

Palmer's parole records and the superior court's minute orders were not presented to the Court of Appeal because the relevant events occurred after the Court of Appeal issued its April 5, 2019 decision. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 8.252(a)(2)(B), (D).) Copies of all materials are filed and served with this motion. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 8.252(a)(3).)

Additionally, for the convenience of the Court and the parties, the Board also attaches:

<u>Exhibit Ee</u>: San Francisco County Superior Court, Collaborative Courts, Parole Revocation Court.

Exhibit Ee is publicly available online. The Board is aware of this Court's guidance that a "request for judicial notice of published material is unnecessary. Citation to the material is sufficient." (See, e.g., *Quelimane Co. v. Stewart Title Guaranty Co.* (1998) 19 Cal.4th 26, 45, fn. 9, citing Stop Youth Addiction v. Lucky Stores, Inc. (1998) 17 Cal.4th 553, 571, fn. 9; see also People v. Rodriguez (2012) 55 Cal.4th 1125, 1129, fn. 4 [same].) Accordingly, this exhibit is attached only for the convenience of the Court and the parties to provide a complete picture of Palmer's status on parole.

Petitioner respectfully requests this Court grant the motion for judicial notice.

On 9/13/2019, at approximately 0730 hours, Agent of Record (AOR) received notification from PSC staff that Subject was "absent without leave" as of 9/12/2019 at 1734 hours, as detailed above. AOR confirmed the above mentioned with PSC Program Manager J. Carpenter. Additionally, AOR obtained a copy of Subject's text message to PSC Program Manager J. Carpenter stating he was "headed to the mountains." It should be noted that the PSC and the Division of Adult Parole Operations (DAPO) did not authorize stated absence and/or travel. On 9/14/2019, at approximately 1825 hours, Subject walked into the San Francisco Police Department (SFPD), Tenderloin Station, and informed Officers that he had an active warrant for his arrest. Officers on duty confirmed the above mentioned warrant was, in fact, an active California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR), Division of Adult Parole Operations, no ball felony warrant. Subsequently, Subject was arrested and booked into San Francisco County Jali (SFCJ) for PC 3056 Parole Violation.

The PSC and the Division of Adult Parole Operations (DAPO) did not authorize stated absence and/or travel. As a result, an emergency DAPO warrant was placed into effect for Subject's arrest due to the fact that he could not be accounted for and his whereabouts were unknown. There is grave concern that Subject's current, and continued, criminal activity reflects prior criminal activity displayed during controlling offense. Specifically, Subject's 1988 kidnapping with intent to commit robbery, while using a firearm, involved Subject questioning the Victim about his wife and children; then impulsively kidnapping the Victim in order to obtain personal monetary gain. Additionally, Subject's 1986 lewd and lascivious acts with a child involved Subject impulsively, and secretively, observing two (2) minor children masturbate. Finally, recent 2019 parole violations involved entering a business which sells alcoholic beverages, contact with minor's under the age of 18, failure to attend the Parole Outpatient Clinic, loitering near schools/playgrounds, failure to complete substance abuse treatment program, and using a cell phone to video record a female Victim's lower body and undergarments without consent.

To address Subject's criminogenic needs, he has been referred to the Parole Outpatient Clinic (outpatient program), Daily Reporting Center (outpatient program) for substance abuse treatment, and the Geo Care Parolee Service Center (PSC) for transitional housing. Unfortunately, Subject refused to comply with these programs and/or services.

Another deferral of the violation in question to continue on parole, with verbal reprimand, was considered. However, it was deemed inappropriate at this time due to Subject's current PSC program non-compliance, absconding of parole supervision, and public safety. Subject's history of impetuous defiance to statutory law is connected to previous, and documented, acts of violence and/or criminal activity. Additionally, his recent behavior indicates that he is continuing with a criminal lifestyle that involves defiance of his conditions of parole. Based on the totality of circumstances, Agent of Record (AOR) is not in agreement with the Parole Violation Disposition Tracking System (PVDTS) Instrument's recommended response level: Moderately Intensive. Thus, Agent of Record (AOR) is respectfully submitting a request for revocation to allow Subject, and the Division of Adult Parole Operations (DAPO), time to assess and address said behavior.





# EXHIBIT Ee – San Francisco County Superior Court, Collaborative Courts, Parole Revocation Court

The San Francisco Collaborative Courts (SFCC) work with individuals and families in the criminal Justice, Juvenile delinquency, and child welfare systems who are challenged by substance abuse, mental illness and other social welfare concerns. Our programs aim to improve individual and family outcomes, minimize incarceration, reduce criminal recidivism and improve public safety. Judicial leadership plays a significant role in motivating participant compliance. Collaborative Courts adhere to principles that combine the values of treatment and rehabilitation with a focus on accountability and public safety.

### **ADULT PROGRAMS**

Behavioral Health Court (BHC) addresses the complex needs of mentally III defendants, including those with cooccurring substance use disorders. An individualized treatment plan is developed which includes psychiatric rehabilitation services, medication management, supportive living, substance abuse treatment, supported employment, and case management services. <u>Staff: Judge Harry Dorfman, Lisa Lightman</u>

Community Justice Center (CJC) is a Court and Service Center for the Tenderloin, Civic Center, and SOMA neighborhoods. The CJC accesses defendants for substance abuse, mental health, and primary care because staff is available in the same building as the court. In partnership with the Department of Public Health (DPH), services at the CJC are available for all residents who live in the CJC area. Staff: Judge Michael Begert, Allyson West

Drug Court (DC) provides an intensive supervision case management program for non-violent offenders with substantial substance abuse problems. When a participant successfully completes Drug Court (10-24 months), probation is terminated or charges may be dismissed. Drug Court has its own treatment clinic and is supported by state funding through DPH. Staff: Judge Michael Begert, Lisa Lightman

Intensive Supervision Court (ISC) is a voluntary court-based probation supervision program spearheaded by the Adult Probation Department. The target population is high-risk, high-need probationers who are facing a state prison commitment as a result of probation violations. Staff: Judge Loretta Giorgi, Lisa Lightman

Parole Revocation Court (PRC) is a collaborative team that supports the delivery of social services to up to 10-12 parolees who have a Petition to Revoke Parole. If a client is unable to fulfill his or her treatment obligations and is not adhering to the treatment plan, the client will be subject to additional remedial sanctions, a possible new parole violation or termination from PRC. This program is supported by a grant from the Judicial Council of California. Staff: Judge Stephen Murphy, Lisa Lightman

Veterans Justice Court (VJC) addresses the Issues confronting military service veterans: substance abuse, mental health disabilities (including post-traumatic stress disorder), homelessness and unemployment. In partnership with the Veterans Administration and other agencies, VJC provides treatment, counseling, social service support and academic and vocational skill training. Staff: Judge Michael Begert, Allyson West
