The Court has requested that counsel advise the Court and opposing counsel of those issues on which counsel expects to focus at oral argument, calendared for February 2, 2021, at 9:00 a.m., in San Francisco. As counsel for respondent, I intend to focus on those issues raised by appellant and the Court at oral argument. Specifically, I will respond to the following issues on which appellant intends to focus:

Argument 3 (AOB 47-146): the trial judge allegedly engaged in misconduct and was biased against appellant resulting in a fundamentally unfair trial;

Argument 13 (AOB 327-371) and Argument 24 (AOB 593-604): the trial court allegedly erred when it instructed the jury that it could consider discovery violations attributed to appellant as a basis for guilt and as a basis for the sentence of death;

Argument 19 (AOB 485-510): the exclusion of testimony from defense expert Dr. Kyle Boone during the penalty phase allegedly violated her right to present mitigating evidence.
