- DMV last reported that 612,831 Californians currently have a suspended driver's license for failure to appear/failure to pay traffic tickets.⁵
- There are an estimated 6.0 million amnesty-eligible accounts (violations initially due prior to Jan. 1, 2013) in California worth an estimated \$5.0 billion. This calculation reflects data from only some of the trial courts; actual numbers may be higher and could be reflected in subsequent reports.
- Counties/Courts not reporting in this period: Mendocino, and San Bernardino.
- Compared to revenue projections through September 2015, several branch funds, including court
 construction and operations, are showing significant estimated revenue decreases since October
 2015, which coincides with the launch of the amnesty program.
