DA Emails Eligible Filings to PRAS • Sr. DPO Screens Cases for Eligibility

- Referrals Should be Received Prior to 11:00 a.m. Ineligible Defendants Not Screened
- Defendants With Any Type of Hold
 Sentenced Prisoners or "No Bail" Cases
- Out on Bail/OR for a Felony Offense

- DPO Summarizes the Probable Cause Declaration
- Obtains Prior Criminal History Information
- PRAS Screens Non-Prison Eligible, 1170(h) Filings
- Must Reside in Ventura County
- Scheduled to Appear for First Arraignment at 1:30 p.m.

Pretrial Services Process

Probation Interviews Each Defendant • Conducts In-Custody Interviews • Obtains Statement for Pretrial Report Probation Uses ORAS-PAT

- First 3 of the 7 Questions Answered by DPO
 Last 4 Questions Answered by Defendant

- Probation Writes Pretrial Report

 Drug, Alcohol, Stolen Property or Stay Away
 Terms may be Recommended

 Sr. DPO Appears in Court with Pretrial Reports

 Provides Intake Appt. Dates for those Released

- Low Score= OR with no
- Moderate Score= OR with Pretrial Supervision
- High Score= No recommendation for release
- Defendant's refusal to be interviewed= no recommendation for release

Pretrial Supervision The probation officer will meet with each defendant for check-in appointments on a weekly basis for the first four weeks and bi-weekly thereafter. For each defendant that is released OR, probation will mail a reminder notice one week prior to their court date and will either email, call or text each defendant the day before their court date.



- Tests Positive for Drugs or Alcohol
- Fails to Report to Probation as directed
- Arrested/Cited for a New Offense



Violations of Pretrial Supervision

- Satisfactory Performance
- Poor Performance
- Sentenced on Pending Offense
- Bench Warrant Issued
- Returned to Custody for a New Offense
