Pursuant to your request, I conducted a Psychotropic Medication Review for the above-referenced minor and have completed the Consultant Physician Review Request. My recommendation is that the Court authorize the requested Klonopin (clonazepam).

Jonathan is a 13-year-old male, date of birth 08/18/2002 who resides in a foster home. Jonathan is under the care of Child and Adolescent Psychiatrist Mukund Gnanadesikan, MD. Dr. Gnanadesikan has diagnosed Jonathan with Autism Spectrum Disorder, Encopresis, Enuresis, Unspecified Anxiety Disorder and Disruptive Mood Dysregulation Disorder. Dr. Gnanadesikan furthermore writes that he has failed many prior psychotropic medication trials including Adderall XR (dextroamphetamine and amphetamine), Concerta (methylphenidate) Risperdal (risperidone), Depakote (valproic acid), Zyprexa (olanzapine), Abilify (aripiprazole) and lithium. He reports that Jonathan has medical problems related to his enuresis and encopresis and poor hygiene because he has skin infections, and that Jonathan is opposed to the medication. Dr. Gnanadesikan reports that even though he has failed medications, he has been a year off medications now and has done worse and has symptoms of extreme irritability, impulsivity and physical aggression in addition to the encopresis and enuresis.
