DSM History • DSM I - 1952, theory-driven - 1968, slight move from psychoanalytic theory – 1980, major shift toward empiricism • DSM IV - 1994, comprehensive literature review, emphasis on empiricism continues New and Revised Disorders

Neurodevelopmental Disorders

- Intellectual Disability (Intellectual Developmental Disorder) v
 Mental Retardation
- Communication Disorders (Language, speech, fluency, and/or social disorder)
- Autism Spectrum Disorder (encompasses autism, Asperger's, childhood disintegrative, and pervasive developmental disorder NOS)—SYMPTOMS IN TWO KEY AREAS: Social communication/ interaction and Repetitive behaviors.
- Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (two symptom domains; onset by age 12; adults-lower threshold
- Specific Learning Disorders
- Motor Disorders

Schizophrenia Spectrum and Other Psychotic Disorders

- Schizophrenia (delusions, hallucinations, disorganized speech, grossly abnormal psychomotor behavior, negative symptoms) ELIMINATION OF ALL SUBTYPES
- Schizoaffective Disorder (Major mood episode present majority of duration).
- Delusional Disorder (No longer requires delusions be "non-bizarre")
- Catatonia (A specifier that can be added to psychotic, bipolar, depressive or other medical disorder or condition

Bipolar and Related Disorders

- Bipolar and Related Disorders (Emphasis changes in activity and energy as well as mood; removal of "mixed episode" and added "with mixed features")
- Other Specified Bipolar and Related Disorders
- Anxious Distress Specifier

Depressive Disorders

- Disruptive Mood Dysregulation Disorder (DMDD): temper outbursts; overreacting to common stressors; outbursts 3+ times/wk. over 1 year; not symptom free for more than 3 months at a time; children age 6-18)
- Major Depressive Disorder: Removal of BEREAVEMENT criteria; Addition of "w/mixed features and "w/anxious distress" specifiers
- Persistent Depressive Disorder (Dysthymia)
- Premenstrual Dysphoric Disorder

- Generalized Anxiety Disorder
- Specific Phobia
- Panic Disorder
- Agoraphobia
- Social Anxiety Disorder (Social Phobia)
- Separation Anxiety Disorder
- Selective Mutism


