

Define the Problem



- 1. Domestic violence is prevalent throughout our communities.
- 2. Victims of domestic violence face unique barriers in seeking temporary restraining orders from the court.
- 3. Excessive clerical time to process temporary restraining orders.

Different Perspectives



- 1. Judicial commitment to help DV victims.
- 2. Court's Executive Officer:
 - 6,700 DV cases filed per year
 - Efficiency \$\$
- 3. Self-Help:
 - Lots of standardized forms (26 ≥ 50 pages)
 - Forms require repetitive data
 - Insufficient factual basis
 - Mostly self-represented litigants (messy/incomplete)

Solution: eFax Filing Program



- Two parts:
 - 1. Interactive Form Completion
 - LawHelp Interactive HotDocs
 - Modified existing program designed by AOC -DASH
 - 2. eFax Filing
 - Court developed

Interactive Form Completion




- User answers questions, does not fill out forms (Like Turbo Tax®).
- Answers to questions determine the next question asked.
- Program selects and fills-in necessary forms.

eFax Filing



- Victim:
 - 1. Easier to complete forms.
 - Does not have to come to court to file a request for a DVRO.
 - 3. Can choose to pick up their documents at a convenient court location.
 - 4. Available 24/7.
- Court:
 - 1. Legible & more complete documents.
 - 2. Increase efficiency.
 - 3. Save money.









