

Evolution of the Program

In FY2021, the child support program collected \$32.7 billion

The child support program served

13.2 million children

66% of child support was collected by income withholding from an employee's paycheck. (34% other sources)

96% of child support collected went to families.

(4% reimbursed public assistance dollars)


\$5.27 collected by the child support program for every \$1.00 spent





In FY2020, tribal child support programs collected \$58 million

96% of child support collected went to families.


74% of cases have a child support order.
