

### **Redirecting Payments**

- No one resides in Order state.
- CP receiving IV-D services.
- Court or Agency in ORDER state can redirect to SDU of services state.

- Consolidated Arrears
- Including INTEREST

### Controlling (Only) Order


- Determines <u>prospective</u> support.
- Interest applies to future missed payments AND arrears.
- Fixes the duration. No subsequent order.






# UIFSA 2008 – non Hague If a foreign country lacks or refuses to exercise jurisdiction, state • May assume and bind • Consent N/A • Residence of petitioner N/A Order is the Controlling Order


# Modification

### **UIFSA 2008**

### **Hague Convention Country**

- ★ Not if creditor remains in issuing state unless by consent or failure to object
- ★ If a foreign tribunal lacks or refuses to exercise jurisdiction
