





Family Code § 4009

An original order for child support may be made retroactive to the date of filing the petition, complaint, or other initial pleading. If the parent ordered to pay support was not served with the petition, complaint, or other initial pleading within 90 days after filing and the court finds that the parent was not intentionally evading service, the child support order shall be effective no earlier than the date of service.

IV-D Default Process

Family Code § 17400(d)(2)

Complaint form contains notice that the proposed judgment will become effective upon failure to file Answer with court within 30 days of service

Family Code § 17430(a) & (b)

Notwithstanding any other law, judgment that conforms to proposed judgment shall be entered without hearing, the presentation of evidence, or further notice to defendant

Discussion of Issue

 DCSS is informed that some courts may be altering default judgments where service took place >90 days after filing

Ouery data: Time from S&C filing → service

Goal: Review current statistics – how long does it take to serve?


Goal: If there is a lag, why?

Goal: Review policy and legislative history of FC § 4009 to determine which party bears the burden of proving either non-evasion or evasion



Ouery Results Data set: All S&Cs filed 6/1/2013 – 15/31/2016 Intent to capture any S&C that could have been served within past 3 years Some S&Cs remain eligible for service





FC § 4009 Solutions File Amended Summons & Complaint to change commencement date, where LCSA did not have good locate Review and improve locate process, if necessary Suggested legal change, to permit Amended Proposed Judgment to be used to change commencement date

Referrals

- Assignment of rights

CDSS & DCSS determine if referable and recoupable

Over 50 aid codes (attachment)

Automated - three IV-A systems

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Unique Aid Codes

K1 & 3F

Implemented 10/1/2013

Child-only cases: at least 1 child is eligible for CalWORKS

Adults in home are unable to meet WPR requirements

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Unique Aid Codes cont.

K1 & 3F - fully state funded program no Federal TANF money is included

Neither referable nor recoupable

Classified as "assisted" by IV-A

Considered "formerly assisted" for child support distribution

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K1 & 3F - Parties cannot stipulate to zero order Court may deviate with appropriate review of circumstances

Unique Aid Codes cont. Approved Relative Caregiver 2P, 2S, 2T Effective 1/1/2015 Establish equity – Caregivers ineligible for AFDC-FC equal to those who are eligible

Unique Aid Codes cont. Repeal of Maximum Family Grant (MFG) Effective 1/1/2017 Child support received for former MFG will be assigned to state
