















## Personal Identifiable Information (PII) Form

- New OCSE Intergovernmental form
- Removes information from forms filed in court such as:
  - Address,
  - Date of birth
  - SSN
- Interplay with Nondisclosure Order
- California Courts and IV-D agency must determine which will retain this form







- Controlling Order

- Including INTEREST


## Controlling (Only) Order


- Determines <u>prospective</u> support.
- Interest applies to future missed payments AND arrears.
- Fixes the duration. No subsequent order.



















































