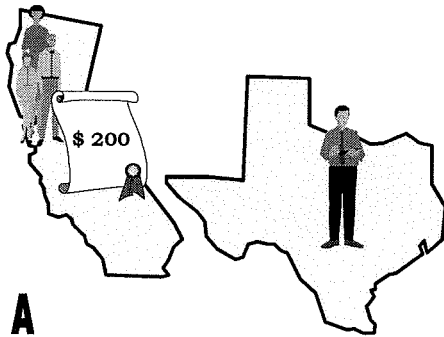


UIFSA Modification Scenarios



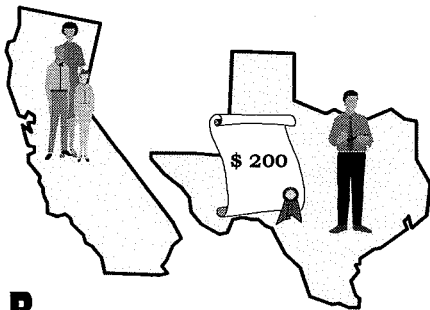
A

One Order = CEJ state = controlling order

Obligee/ "home" state

Enforcement - anywhere with jurisdiction over obligor's person or property; can have simultaneous enforcement in multiple states

Modification - CEJ state, unless all parties agree in writing for another state (obligor) to assume CEJ



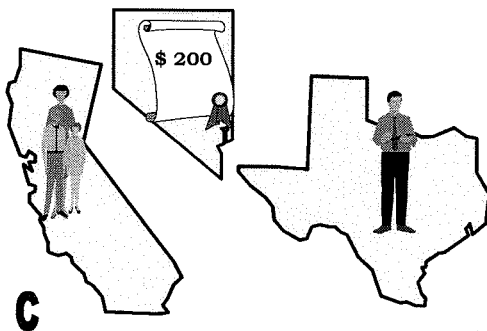
B

One Order = CEJ state = controlling order

Obligor state

Enforcement - anywhere with jurisdiction over obligor's person or property; can have simultaneous enforcement in multiple states

Modification - CEJ state, unless all parties agree in writing for another state (obligee) to assume CEJ



C

One Order = CEJ state = controlling order

Enforcement - anywhere with jurisdiction over obligor's person or property; can have simultaneous enforcement in multiple states

Modification* - Petitioner must "play away" and have responding state assume CEJ, unless all parties agree in writing for CEJ to go to petitioner's state or remain in issuing state.

*** If one person in another country, the original order issuing state retains CEJ**
