**Quarter 4**

1. **Section 1.B. AB 139 Civil Assessment -- The County has informed the Court that they are unable to separately identify their collections from FTB collections at this time. They are currently developing the requirements for a new CMS that is projected to go live sometime in 2008-2009. They have indicated that they will build this reporting mechanism into the new CMS.**

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2. **Line #1670 "Night Court: -- This section is labeled "Other County Fines and Forfeitures", however, Sacramento Court retains this revenue source until 1/1/09, not the County.**

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3. **Line #1711 "900 telephone numbers": -- This section is labeled "Other County Fines and Forfeitures", however, Sacramento Court retains this revenue source, not the County.**

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4. **2nd Qtr - Line 1750-11-02 "County Cost of Collections on Civil Assessment": The County of Sacramento Department of Revenue Recovery began identifying the cost of delinquent collections effective November 2008.**

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5. **2nd Qtr - Line 1750-13-02 "Third Party Cost of Collections on Civil Assesement": 1st Qtr Cost reported in error; should have been \$-60,975.38. 2nd Qtr cost is \$-68,144.78. Grand total for 1st and 2nd Qtrs is \$-129,120.16.**

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6. **3rd Qtr - Line 1750-11-02 "County Cost for Civil Assessment Collections": Costs for our County collections were not posted in time for the March TC-145 report, so the costs for March were reported in our April TC-145 report. However, costs for County Civil Assessment are recorded in the appropriate month for the RoR.**

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
